

Airtel Malawi Donates Hunger Relief Items To 2,000 Households And 10 Schools

Lilongwe, Malawi - 28 January 2026 - Airtel Africa Foundation through Airtel Malawi Plc has today donated maize and soya blend porridge flour to 2,000 vulnerable households and 10 primary schools in Blantyre Rural and Chikwawa Districts, in fulfillment of the K300 million support donation done in December last year.

The donation has been made in collaboration with the Department of Disaster Management Affairs (DoDMA) and the Malawi Red Cross Society ensuring a coordinated and effective distribution to the intended beneficiaries.

Speaking during the handover, **Airtel Malawi Enterprise Director, Mr. Limbani Ngoma**, said the initiative reflects the company's commitment to supporting communities in times of need.

"Airtel Malawi is committed to standing with communities during difficult times.
