



Government has commended Airtel Zambia for its continued investment in strengthening the country's digital infrastructure, following site inspections led by the Minister of Technology and Science, Hon. Felix Mutati, at the Nyumba Yanga and Chalala (Shantumbu) sites in Lusaka. "Zambians raised concerns about quality of service. We engaged Airtel, and today we are seeing that commitment translated into action," said Hon. Mutati.

The Minister welcomed Airtel's US\$107 million investment to upgrade and roll out over 400 network sites, describing it as a significant step toward improving service quality, expanding coverage and enabling participation in the digital economy.

Airtel Zambia Managing Director Hussam Baday reaffirmed the company's commitment to delivering a more reliable and resilient network, with all sites under the programme set to be fully operational by March 2026.
